

HELP US KEEP LAWSON'S LANDING OPEN

The **California Coastal Commission** is going to decide soon whether Lawson's Landing can remain open as a low-cost campground, fishing, and boating resort. The Commission has already indicated they want most of the property closed. Powerful elitist environmental organizations, including the Marin Sierra Club, the Marin Audubon Society, and the Environmental Action Committee of West Marin have been pressuring the Commission to close Lawson's Landing. Without any scientific evidence, they claim the campground uses harm Tomales Bay and the environment. *Please*, we need **YOUR** support to help keep Lawson's Landing open!!!

What you can do:

- (1) **Contribute** to the Lawson's Landing Legal Defense Fund. We need money to challenge the Coastal Commission's decision in court. - (2) **Write** the California Coastal Commission and tell them what the Lawson Landing experience means to you and your family. Mention how long you have been camping here, how affordable it is, how unique a camping experience it is, where you come from, etc. They need to understand how precious a resource this is for California families, especially families of low and moderate incomes. Closing down Lawson's Landing, or making it impossible for the landowners to stay in business -- by limiting their revenue in removing the permanent trailers -- will severely limit coastal access for everyone. Include your name/address in the letter and request to be notified of any hearings.
- (3) **Or fill out and mail** a "form letter" if you can't write a personal letter (available to print out and mail at: savelawsonslanding.com)
